**Delzotti, Engel Named to State Association Board**

LEXINGTON, Ky. – Kentucky Nonprofit Network (KNN), the state association of nonprofit organizations, has elected two new members to its board of directors: Michael Delzotti of Lexington, President and CEO of the University of Kentucky Markey Cancer Foundation, and Alan Engel of Louisville, retired Nonprofit executive and active community volunteer.

Delzotti brings over twenty-four years of experience to KNN’s nine-member board. Prior to joining the Foundation in 2015, he held senior leadership positions at MD Anderson Cancer Center, Rice University, UCLA and Special Olympics of Southern California. Delzotti is Vice Chair of External Relations on the Association of Fundraising Professionals (AFP) International Board, Chair-Elect of the National Association of Cancer Center Development Officers, a member of the Certified Fund Raising Executive (CFRE) International Participating Organization Advisory Council and a Paul Harris Fellow of the Rotary International Foundation.

Engel, likewise, brings extensive experience to the KNN board. He served as the Executive Director of the Jewish Community Federation of Louisville for over twenty-two years, retiring in October 2010. He served as a board member and board chair of the Coalition for the Homeless, was one of the founding members of the Kentucky Community Service Commission, and served on numerous committees of the Jewish Federations of North America. Engel currently serves on the board of directors of The Healing Place in Louisville; JPRO, a national board of Jewish Communal Professionals; and as Treasurer of the American Friends of the Western Galilee Medical Center.
